member or loved one. Each name will be engraved on a plaque affixed to one of over 1,000 seats available.



**Seats are limited...**get yours before it's too late! As a seat donor, you will receive your name or the name of a loved one engraved on a plaque that will be permanently affixed to the theater seat in the Carnegie of Homestead's Historic Music Hall. The name plate remains in place for the life of the seat making this essentially a permanent naming opportunity.

Your seat sponsorship is a donation to the Carnegie Library of Homestead and is tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law. All contributions will be used for operational cost, educational programming, and to maintian the structural, technical and aestethic quality of the Carnegie of Homestead's Music Hall.

You have a choice to provide payment in full to receive a 10% discount, or you may elect to pay in 10 equal installments payable monthly, with the first payment due upon submission of form. You may receive a 10% discount for sponsoring 4 or more seats. (Please, only one discount per order.)

When selecting an inscription, please be kind, tasteful and use language that is acceptable by The Carnegie's mission and standards. We have the right to reject any verbiage that is not acceptable.

The Carnegie of Homestead will honor all requests on a first come, first serve basis. Naming a seat does not reserve the use of the seat for any venue performances. If paying via installment plan, the plaque will be installed 4-6 weeks after final payment is received. Payment will be returned if verbiage cannot be agreed upon in writing between sponsor and venue.
